

Moderna Booster Dose Attestation

I _____ attest to my need for a boost dose of COVID-19 vaccine based being in one of the following groups and I received my two-dose series of Pizer COVID-19 vaccine or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine as of at least 5 months prior. Or my one dose series of Johnson Johnson COVID-19 vaccine 2 months prior.

- 65 years of age and older
- 18 through 64 years of age at high risk of severe COVID-19
- 18 through 64 years of age with frequent institutional or occupational exposure to CoV-2
- People aged ≥ 50 years and residents aged ≥ 18 years in long-term care settings should receive a single COVID-19 vaccine booster dose (Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, or Janssen) ≥ 5 months after completion of their primary mRNA vaccine series.
- All other persons aged ≥ 18 years may receive a single COVID-19 vaccine booster dose (Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, or Janssen) ≥ 5 months after completion of their primary mRNA vaccine series based on their individual benefits and risks.
- Currently, a Moderna COVID-19 booster dose is **not** recommended in people aged < 18 years.

*Underlying Medical Conditions Include:

- Cancer
- Chronic Kidney disease
- Chronic lung disease, including COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease), asthma (moderate to server), interstitial lung disease, cystic fibrosis, and pulmonary hypertension
- Dementia or other neurological conditions
- Diabetes (type 1 or type 2)
- Down syndrome
- Heart conditions (such as heart failure, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathies or hypertension)
- HIV infection
- Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system)
- Liver disease
- Overweight and obesity
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease or thalassemia
- Smoking, current or former
- Solid organ or blood stem cell transplant
- Stroke or cerebrovascular disease, which affects blood flow to the brain
- Substance use disorder
